WE AIRED A TAPE THAT SIMULATED A SNOWY SCREEN WITH GRAPHICS INSTRUCTING VIEWERS IN ENGLISH AND SPANISH AS TO WHAT IS HAPPENING AND WHAT THEY NEED TO DO. WE GUIDED THEM TO A NATIONAL TOLL-FREE NUMBER AND A NATIONAL WEBSITE. MOST STATIONS IN OUR MARKET ALSO PARTICIPATED IN THE TEST, WHICH WAS DESIGNED TO INTERRUPT AND JAR VIEWERS INTO TAKING ACTION.
